Directions From Sky Harbor Airport in Phoenix: Exiting Sky Harbor Airport on Freeway 202 East, proceed east to Country Club Drive exit. Turn right and drive south to University Drive. Turn left (east) and proceed to Pasadena. Turn right on Pasadena and proceed to the stop sign. Turn right on 2nd Street and then immediately left (between buildings) leading into the parking garage. Proceed to the third level and park. Take the elevator on the west to the 4th floor. Exit the elevator and go left to the reception area.

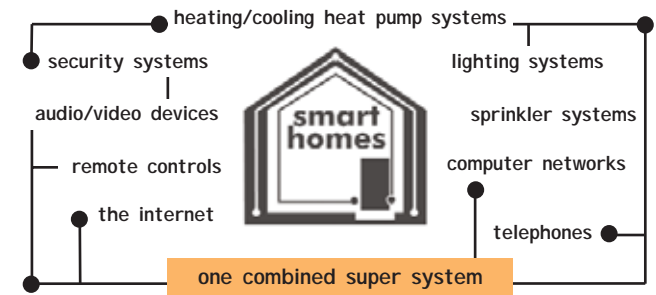

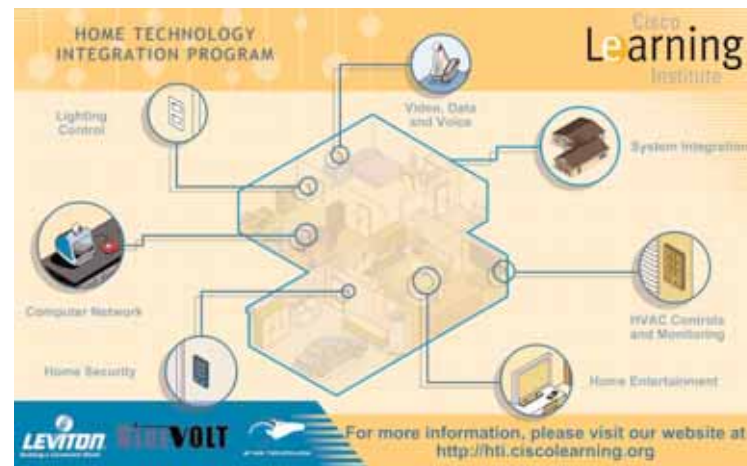
